RULES

Tentative Show Bill

AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD ALL RULE MAY BE ADJUSTED

1. Each exhibitor shows at his/her own risk. M.T.S.C. is not responsible for injury or accident. Owner and exhibitor must sign "HOLD HARMLESS" agreement on entry form before exhibitor may show. Parent/guardian must sign for minors.
2. Youth and Small Fry points are counted on the horse/rider combo. **A YOUTH exhibitor is 18 years and under, a SMALL FRY exhibitor is 12 years and under as of January 1st. Also any SMALL FRY is ineligible to show in a canter/lope class. If they wish to show in a canter/lope class they must show as youth, not small fry. M.T.S.C will request proof of age for small fry/youth if there are any questions of riders age.**
3. Horse to measure over 14.2 hands, Pony to measure 14.2 hands and under. Pet Pony to measure 13.2 hands and under. ALL PONIES WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE MEASURED. Signed record of measurement will be kept on file.
4. HORSES MUST SHOW IN HORSE CLASSES AND PONIES WITH RIDER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST SHOW IN PONY CLASSES.
5. **There will be no excessive hitting or whipping in or out of the show ring. This will result in disbarment from the show and the show committee enforces this rule.**
6. If disbarred from the show, no points will be counted for that show.
7. Youth riders are prohibited from showing stallions in all classes.
8. Any act of discourtesy on the part of an exhibitor, owner, trainer, or family toward the judge or anyone affiliated with the show may disqualify the horse and rider and the owner shall forfeit his/her entry fees and will not be permitted to show in any subsequent classes in that show.
9. Decision of the judge is final on ALL awards. In ALL OTHER matters the decision of the show committee will be FINAL. In case of a argument, a protest fee of \$25 must be rendered. The show committee will review the argument. Their decision will be final. In the decision is in favor of the protestor, the \$25 will be refunded, If not, the fee will be kept by M.T.S.C.
10. One rider per horse per class
11. Owner and exhibitor must be member to receive day end, or year end awards. Seasonal awards count from the day that the rider and owner are both members and the horse is NOMINATED for DIVISIONAL HIGH POINT AWARD.
12. All members and riders are asked to conduct their selves in a manner that will credit M.T.S.C.
13. Western Classes will be governed by AQHA with club adaptations.
14. More then 15 horses in a Canter/ Lope class, the class will be split.
15. More then 20 horses in a Walk/ Jog/Trot class, the class will be split.
16. The exhibitor or person acting on their behalf must fill out the entry forms
17. **Scratches** must be made in the entry booth and **one class prior** to your calls, or you will be billed.
18. In the event of lightening or severe weather-the ring will be cleared immediately.
19. All dogs **must** be on a leash at all times.
20. Please use discretion when lunging in the arena. Please refrain from lunging in the arena after 8:30 A.M.
21. M.T.S.C. board will make weather decisions concerning the shows. In the event of cancellation all shown classes WILL count for points. You may call either number on the show bill to check on show cancellations

Effective 2011, you must be a M.T.S.C. member in order to win day end high point awards and/or to win year end awards

Day of Show Awards

- Jackpot- Classes 10, 21- 80% (40, 30, 20, 10) payback
- Payback 15 or more- \$12,10,8,5,3, ribbon
- 7 to 14 horses- \$10, 8,5,3, ribbon
- 4 to 6 horses- \$5,3,ribbon, ribbon, ribbon
- 1 to 3 horses- ribbon, ribbon

Special Year End Awards that are given out to our members at our annual awards banquet

1. **Bobby Borschlegal Memorial**- awarded to the horse/pony with the most points in Small Fry
2. **John Downin Challenge**- awarded to the horse/pony with the most Youth points.
3. **Kindred Spirits Horsemanship**-- awarded to the horse/pony with the most points in the Youth English division
4. **Pam Miske Memorial**- awarded to the horse/pony with the most points in English and Hunter divisions combined (must of shown in at least 2 over fence classes at each show)
5. **Christal Warne Western Pleasure**- awarded to the horse with the most points in the Junior or Senior Western Pleasure and Open Western Pleasure.
6. All around Adult- \$75 to the horse/rider combination that receives the most points in the adult division
7. All around Youth- \$75 awarded to the horse/rider combination the receives the most point in the youth division
8. All around small fry- \$25 awarded to the horse/rider combination with the most points in the small fry division.
9. All around pony- \$25 awarded to the pony/rider combination with the most points in the pony division.
